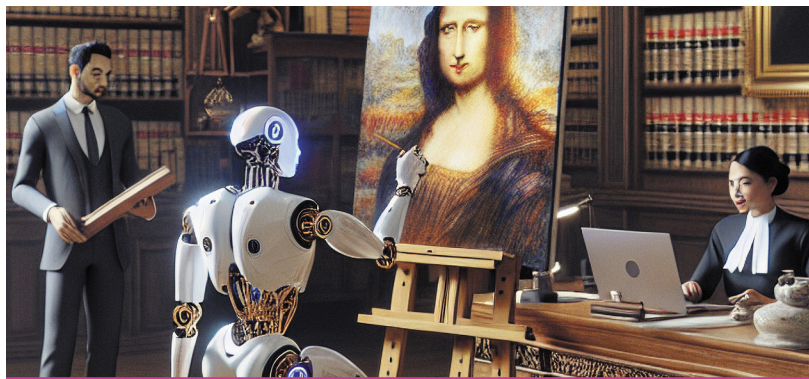

Offering her perspective Gaedt-Sheckter states, “AI can provide extreme efficiency in certain ministerial tasks and assist in decision-making without being the decision-maker itself. It’s a technology we’ve been utilizing and refining for quite some time, and the uses and sophistication just continue to expand.”
